*Ever wondered how patterns are made or wanted to make your own but don't know how? This pattern cutting course will introduce you to the method of flat pattern cutting to create a 'block' pattern & show you some methods that can be used to create patterns for your own designs. Starting with the skirt block (or another simple block if agreed with the tutor in advance) you will create your own block pattern and will be shown some basic methods of pattern design/adaptation that could be applied to the skirt block or other garment types, such as adding seam lines.*
